Revelation 19:1-10 (CSB)

After this I heard something like the loud voice of a vast multitude in heaven, saying,

Hallelujah!

Salvation, glory, and power belong to our God,
because his judgments are true and righteous,
because he has judged the notorious prostitute
who corrupted the earth with her sexual immorality;
and he has avenged the blood of his servants
that was on her hands.

A second time they said,

Hallelujah!

Her smoke ascends forever and ever!

Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and
worshiped God, who is seated on the throne, saying,

Amen! Hallelujah!

A voice came from the throne, saying,

Praise our God,

all his servants, and the ones who fear him,
both small and great!

Then I heard something like the voice of a vast multitude, like the sound of
cascading waters, and like the rumbling of loud thunder, saying,

Hallelujah, because our Lord God, the Almighty,
reigns!

Let us be glad, rejoice, and give him glory,
because the marriage of the Lamb has come,
and his bride has prepared herself.

She was given fine linen to wear, bright and pure.

For the fine linen represents the righteous acts of the saints.

Then he said to me, "Write: Blessed are those invited to the marriage feast of
the Lamb!" He also said to me, "These words of God are true." Then I fell at his
feet to worship him, but he said to me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant
with you and your brothers and sisters who hold firmly to the testimony of
Jesus. Worship God, because the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

The Bride of Christ

In Revelation, we see a breathtaking image of the Church as the Bride of Christ—
beautifully adorned, pure, and ready for the wedding feast of the Lamb. This passage
reminds us that our relationship with Jesus is not distant or formal, but deeply
personal and full of love. Just as a bride prepares herself for her groom, we are
called to live in faithful devotion, keeping our hearts set on Him.

As we worship today, may we remember that Christ's love for His Church is steadfast
and eternal. One day, we will join in that great celebration, clothed not in our own
righteousness, but in the grace He has freely given. Let us live in joyful anticipation
of that glorious day!
