## **Maloy Ministry Moments**

July 2024



"Whoever does not bear his own cross & come after me cannot be my disciple." Luke 14:27

I had seen villages like this before—dozens like it dot the countryside around the capital of this Central Asian country. The families have very little, & were entirely composed of believers of the majority religion. If given the choice between buying food, clothing, farming tools, gasoline, or school supplies, how high do you think school supplies are on Papa's list? But thanks to you, on my recent visit I witnessed over 70 children receive food, clothing, hygiene items, & school supplies. This aid continues to open doors for our staff to enter the homes of these children and build relationships with their parents. It has also allowed for a deep trust to develop between the community leaders, the school leaders & the local Cru staff team. Two of our staff now teach at the school on a part-time basis & routinely share the Gospel with the children!

During a previous visit to this village several years ago, our staff were directed to a family in severe crisis. The head of that family is Feruza\*. Her husband abandoned her & her family years ago when it became apparent that one of their 6 daughters had a severe disability. The Cru staff started visiting her, bringing much needed humanitarian aid. Eventually they began sharing the Gospel with her & today, she & all 6 of her daughters have prayed to receive Christ! This has not come without great cost, as they, being Christians, were seen as unsuitable marriage partners for their country's men, & now they've grown beyond the marrying age. But they are trusting in Jesus to take care of them as they faithfully serve Him. Feruza is the first convert in this village & she hosts a weekly home group where other spiritually interested women come to learn about Jesus!
