Amid Gaza's devastation, a trusted team of five believers, supplied by Unto, continues bringing essential food to families facing extreme hunger. Because resources are scarce, they prioritize the most vulnerable, including children, the wounded, amputees, and the elderly.

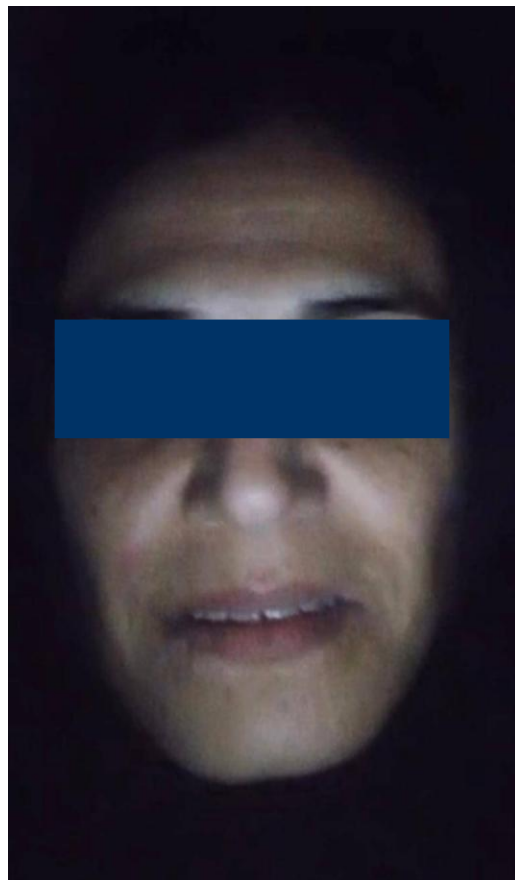
That is how they found Laila*, a young lady living with her mother in a tent. Laila has celiac disease, making it extremely difficult to find food she can safely eat. The team provided food suitable for her needs and, more importantly, made sure she knew she had not been forgotten.

The team then continued following up with Laila and her mother. Through limited communication, Laila has connected with our Cru staff in another part of the country and has begun hearing about Christ's love and considering what it means for her life.

Today, their living conditions remain desperate. They have no income, bathroom, adequate cleaning supplies, or reliable access to clean water. They struggle with illness, insects, mice, extreme heat, and cold. The food and supplies the team provides remain their primary lifeline.

Laila's story shows the crucial role humanitarian aid plays in reaching those in the toughest places with the hope of Christ. Please continue to pray for Laila and her mother and for the safety of our partners in Gaza as they relieve suffering, restore dignity, and reveal the hope of Christ.
